Guidelines for Determining Player Movement/Placement

- **TEAM NEEDS.** Filling rosters with the appropriate level players is the primary focus.
- **PLAYER RECORD.** Previous team records will be checked.
- **PRO EVALUATIONS.** Pros will give input on skill level of every player moved/placed.
- **INTERCLUB HISTORY.** Commitment to the Interclub program is recognized.
- **ATTENTION TO PERSONAL INSTRUCTION.** Private lessons/clinics show commitment.
- **DEDICATION TO TEAM PRACTICE.** Continuity of instruction improves team strength.
- **ATTITUDE.** Working together will ensure the success of the Interclub program.
- **TEAM SPIRIT.** Working with the captain for the good of the team is necessary.
- **NEW MEMBER PLACEMENT.** There is no guarantee of permanent placement on an Interclub team. New players of different skill levels join the club on a regular basis. Players returning to the Interclub program may also influence team rosters.
